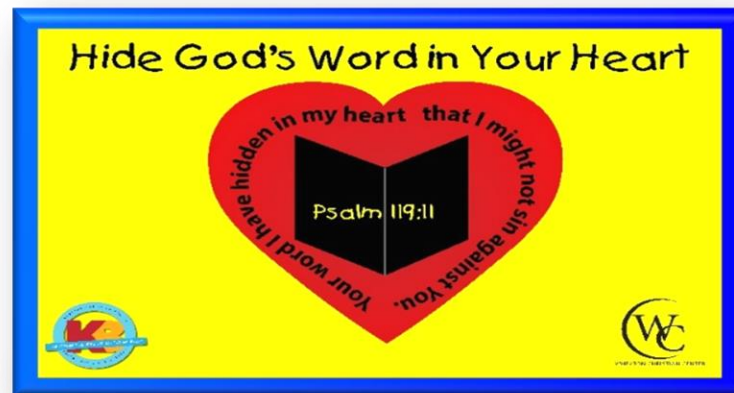

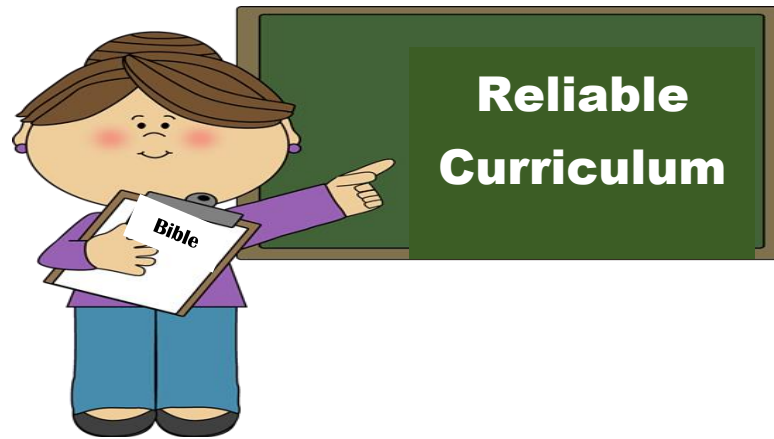

## The Scripture Memorization Team's Vision

**Vision Statement:** In order for our students at WCC to become stronger learners when it comes to memorizing and understanding scripture, which is something important for meeting the goals of our church as well as for the overall benefit of our children, the Scripture Memorization Team proposed this plan. The essence of the plan is to condense the breadth of the scripture verses the students are learning, into smaller increments. This plan will span the entire Kingdom Builders program—Preschool through Super Church—and will be replete with strategies for instruction, assessments, and incentives, thus, enabling the students to become more competent in memorizing and understanding Scripture, so that they can use it to guide their lives. (Adopted September 5, 2019) (Revised March 9, 2021)



The materials that are used within the Scripture Memorization curriculum are those that are vital to effective teaching and the assessment. These materials have been designed to aid the teachers, the parents, and the students in knowing what is to be taught; what is to be studied and memorized; how proficiency is assessed; and how to keep track of student progress.

In order to lend credence to the soundness of this scripture curriculum, the Scripture Memorization Team offers, as evidence, the following criteria that was used in designing the Scripture Memorization curriculum:

- ✓ Thematic Relevancy to the Topic as well as Relevancy to the Students' Ability to Comprehend the Theme
- ✓ Thematic Reflection of Spiritual Growth for the Students
- ✓ Thematic Organization within and throughout the Various Grade Levels
- ✓ Scriptural Relevancy to the Theme as well as to the Appropriateness to the Students' Ability to Comprehend the Scripture
- ✓ Scripture Verses from Both Old and New Testaments
- ✓ Scriptural Organization to Reflect Continuity from One Grade Level to the Next



# Kingdom Builders Righteous Seed Dollar Points System

The Kingdom Builders Righteous Seed Dollar Points is a system by which students receive dollar points for their accurate recitation of the specific scripture verses within their grade-level themes and/or for the Bonus Blessing Passages that are contained within this *Scripture Memorization Booklet*. With their Righteous Seed Dollar Points, students are able to purchase items from our KB Store.

- **Who Receives Righteous Seed Dollar Points?**  
Students who accurately recite any of the Theme scripture verses and/or Bonus Blessing Passages from among those found within this *Scripture Memorization Booklet* are eligible to receive Righteous Seed Dollar Points.
- **When Do Students Get Opportunities to Recite Their Scripture Passages?**
  - ✓ During their **weekly Sunday School class**, students are given the opportunity to recite their memorized scripture verses, with understanding, for the Assessment Volunteers.
- **When Do Students Get to Use Their Dollar Points?**
  - ✓ Every Sunday, students will be able to **shop** at The KB Store in room 142, accompanied by either their teacher or an Assessment Volunteer.
- **How Many Attempts Can Students Have to Recite a Particular Scripture Passage?**
  - ✓ If students are unable to accurately recite the particular scripture verse(s) and/or Bonus Blessing Passage(s), they are able to try again throughout the month.



### Version 3

- ✓ Once the new, monthly theme and Scriptures are assigned, the students are able to recite any past Scriptures as time permits, throughout subsequent months and will receive the allocated RSDP for doing so.
- ✓ Students may recite other Scripture apart from those found in this *Scripture Memorization Booklet*, but they will not be eligible to receive Righteous Seed Dollar Points.
- ✓ Once students accurately recite the memorized scripture verse(s) and/or Bonus Blessing Passage(s), and are given the Righteous Seed Dollar Points, they cannot get rewarded for those same verses and/or Bonus Blessing Passages again.

★ Because we want our students to build up their scripture “treasury,” they cannot repeat Scripture for which they have already received credit in previous grade levels.

***NOTE: All Scripture used in the Scripture Memorization Curriculum is taken from the New King James Version (NKJV) of the Bible.***



## Tying It All Together

In order for parents, teachers, and students to understand the scripture curriculum materials better, we have included explanations regarding the following information:

### The Sunday School Scripture Curriculum Calendar

The Sunday School Scripture Year is comprised of forty-four weeks of Scripture learning, from September through June, and an 8-week Summer Enrichment Scripture Session, during July and August. The schedule is shown in the following calendar:

## Important Terms You Should Know

- **What are Topics?**

*Topics* for the scripture curriculum represent those areas, in the lives of our students, that are foundational in establishing them as strong Christians and effective soul-winners.

- **What are Themes?**

*Themes* are those focus areas that relate to the topics. Each topic has one specific theme. The topics are the same for each grade level, but the themes vary per grade level.

- **What about the Scripture Verses?**

*Scripture Verses* are assigned to each theme and correlate to both the theme and the topic. Each theme has at least one scripture verse. Scripture verses are designated according to grade-level comprehension.

- **What are Bonus Blessing Passages?**

*Bonus Blessing Passages* are scripture passages and statements of belief that are more substantial than the typical scripture verses within the grade-level scripture curriculum. Because of their length, the Bonus Blessing Passages have a greater Righteous Seed Dollar Point value than the other scripture verses.

### How Does It All Tie Together?

During each curriculum quarter, students are required to learn, memorize, recite, and understand their designated scripture verses that are a part of the grade level themes for that particular quarter. Once the students learn, memorize, recite, and understand the scripture verses for a grade level theme, they will receive the Righteous Seed Dollar Points allocated to that theme. Also, any student, at any grade level, is encouraged to learn, memorize, and recite the Bonus Blessing Passages. Once the students learn and recite any of these “extra credit” passages, they will receive the Righteous Seed Dollar Points allocated to the passage.

## The KB Store: “How Students Cash-in Their RSDP”

- **The KB Store is open every Sunday in Room 142.**
- The process for the students choosing and receiving their prizes is as follows:
  - ✓ The students will be escorted to the KB Store by their teacher or by an Assessment Volunteer.
  - ✓ The student, the teacher, or the Assessment Volunteer will fill out ***The Official KB Store Order Form***, which will be clamped onto clipboards, located in the KB Store.
  - ✓ The student, teacher, or Assessment Volunteer will place ***The Official KB Store Order Form*** into the box that will be located on the desk in Room 142.
  - ✓ The students will need to have ***The Official KB Store Order Form*** with them when purchasing prizes.
  - ✓ All ***The Official KB Store Order Forms*** are to be placed in the designated box in the KB Store in Room 142 by the end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday Service every month.
  - ✓ The prizes will be wrapped and prepared for the parents to pick up on the 4<sup>th</sup> or 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of the month.
  - ✓ Parents will find their children’s prizes on a table near the KB Desk area.
  - ✓ Prizes will be sent to the classroom teachers for them to distribute, if they are not picked up by the parents on the 4<sup>th</sup> or 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of the month.

***\*Teachers, please be sure to remind your students that they have prizes for their parents to pick up.***

## **ASSESSMENT VOLUNTEERS**



The Assessment Volunteers is a team of professional and reliable teachers from our church that volunteer every Sunday, to listen to our students recite their scriptures. Each Sunday, two Assessment Volunteers work together to ensure that the assessment of the students' scripture recitations is as accurate as possible, being guided by the Scripture Memorization Grade Level Scoring Rubrics.

The purpose of this team is to assist our Sunday School classroom teachers in assessing and recording the students' scripture recitations. They also assist the teachers by escorting classes to the KB Store, in order for the students to redeem their Righteous Seed Dollar Points that they will have earned by reciting their Scriptures.

The Assessment Volunteers work cooperatively with the classroom teachers every Sunday. The AV walks to each class to personally escort no more than two [2] students at a time. The students, Scripture Memorization folders in hand, are taken to the listening room. The AVs asks each individual student what scripture he/she would like to recite. Then, the AVs listen to the student and use the designated grade level scoring rubric to assess the student's recitation. The AVs mark the individual student's recording sheet and tell the student how many RSDP he or she has earned. The student is then given a sticker on his/her sticker chart and escorted back to the classroom. When the student returns to his class, he/she hands his/her folder to the teacher. This prompt form of communication shows the teacher how well the student did with reciting the scripture verse(s).

This team of people has become a very integral part of our Scripture Memorization program, and the teachers and the students have all been blessed by their selfless service.

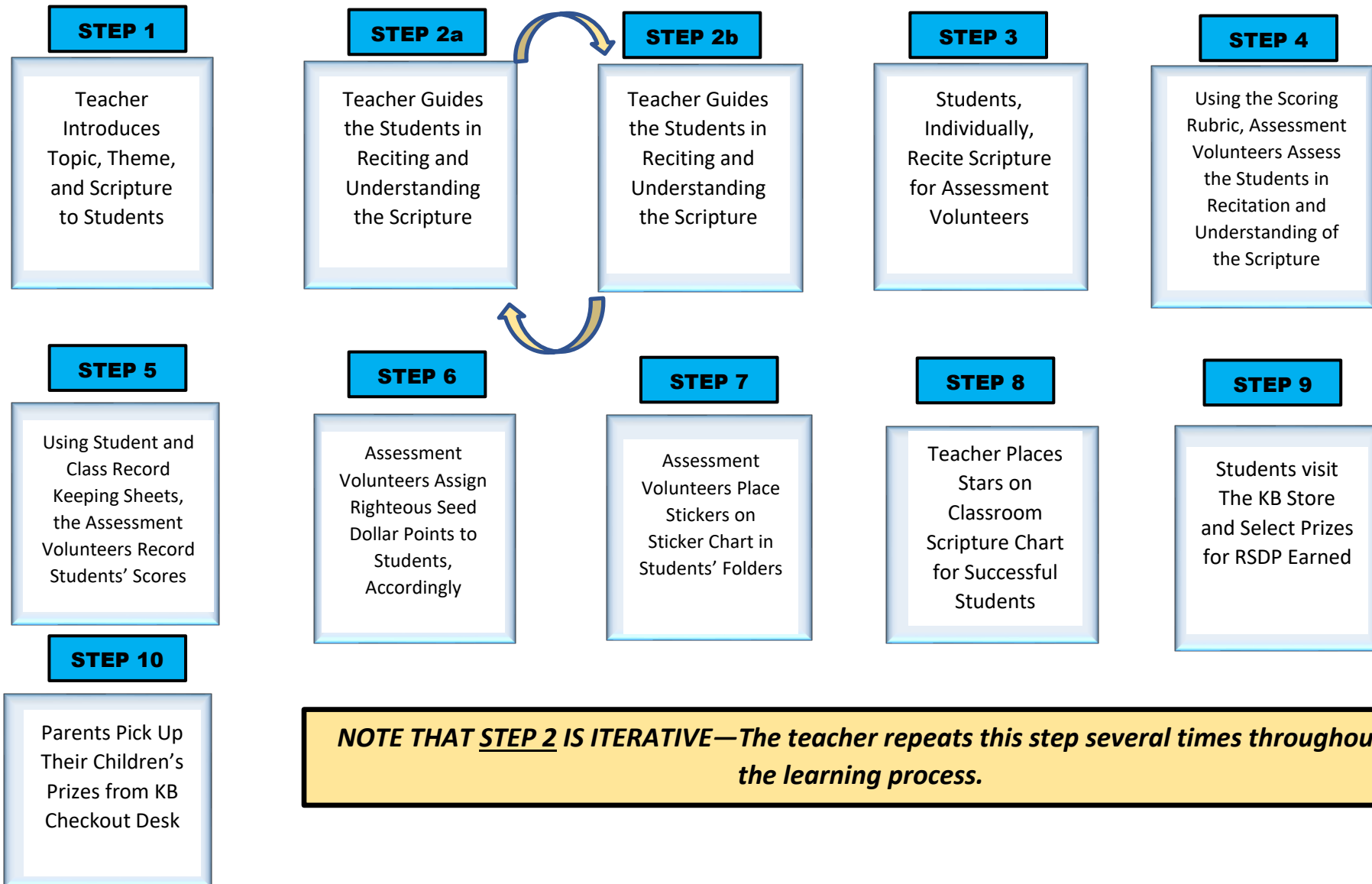

# Kingdom Builders Scripture Memorization Strategies

Below are strategies that can help KB children memorize Scripture according to their individual learning styles. All of these ideas were suggested by the teachers within our KB ministry. Some strategies will overlap into other categories. What is most important for proficiency is the comfort level of the individual student. Some students may even be comfortable learning in multiple styles.

## Things to Remember for Teaching the Scripture Curriculum

Teachers, here are a few instructional guidelines for when you are teaching the scripture curriculum:

1. You should dedicate 15 minutes to scripture learning.
  - a. The 15 minutes should alternate, weekly, between the following:
    - (1) introducing the Scripture(s);
    - (2) strategies for memorizing the Scripture;
    - (3) lessons on understanding the Scripture;
    - (4) class scripture recitation practice;
    - (5) and assessment of student recitations for the Righteous Seed Dollar Points.
2. By the end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of the month, Assessment Volunteers should have assessed the students for reciting and understanding the Scriptures for the month.
3. By the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of the month, teachers or Assessment Volunteers should have taken the students to the KB Store for redeeming their RSDP. (The teachers and/or AVs will fill out the Official KB Order Form and place it in the box in Room 142.)
4. The last Sunday of the month is when the parents will pick up their children's packaged prizes near the KB Desk.

Bonus Blessing Passages have a greater value than the other Scriptures. Any student, at any grade level, is encouraged to learn and recite these “extra credit” passages. The Righteous Seed Dollar Point value is listed for each passage, along with the associated word counts.




